The ground floor comprises a welcoming entrance hall with built in storage, a downstairs WC, a lounge open plan to a dining room, a stylish contemporary kitchen and a conservatory style utility room to the side of property. Bi-folding doors lead you from the dining room into the rear garden.

The well equipped kitchen includes a central island unit with quartz worksurfaces, a built in double oven, integrated induction hob with gas ring, extractor and space for a side by side fridge/freezer and dishwasher.

Stairs lead you from the hallway to the first floor where there are three generous bedrooms and a shower room with a walk-in shower cubicle. A second staircase leads you from the landing to a useful loft room providing office space.

The beautifully landscaped garden benefits from a paved patio, a well tended lawn and a luxury garden studio at the foot of the garden with a hot tub adjacent. The garden studio provides the perfect entertaining space and has a sauna room with shower facility. The front driveway offers off street parking for one car. Additionally, the property has recently had the roof replaced.

Situated in a desired location, this property is conveniently located for the town centre, mainline station and excellent schools including Yavneh College.


